

With speed frame mounting, the standard installation is up to 4 times faster than traditional mounting methods.

Equipped with jacking bolts and z-adjustment capabilities, the frame ensures precise alignment to compensate for up to a half inch wall irregularities – no shimming needed. Its modular construction features lightweight framing sections that simplify handling and assembly while reducing structural load, ensuring a faster, more reliable installation process.

- ADA Compliant, based on 4" total install depth (panel = 2 1/8", frame = 1 7/8")
- US-manufactured aluminum construction to reduce overall wall load (frame weight = 1.45lb/ft² in addition to NPN product weight)
- Attaches directly to wall, no plywood required
- Seam alignment managed through XYZ adjustment built into each panel, model and frame
- Standard and configurable frame sizes to align with display size
- Keyhole slots for simple stackable panel installation, no need for drilling/no filings to clean up
- Seismic locking plates, rated to 1.6g, meet all US building code requirements
